



# 2018 Application Guidelines

## Who can apply?

The Hill End Artists in Residence Program is open to Australian visual artists, curators and arts writers. International artists are encouraged to apply. Collaborative proposals are accepted. One person should apply on behalf of all applicants.

## What is provided?

Artists in residence have the use of living and working space at either Haefligers Cottage and studio or Murrays Cottage at no cost. Each cottage is fully furnished. Artists provide their own food and transport. For more information visit [www.hillendart.com.au](http://www.hillendart.com.au)

## Considerations?

Pets are not allowed to stay at Haefligers or Murrays Cottages due to the sensitive nature of the heritage interiors and gardens. Accommodation at Haefligers Cottage is not suitable for young children.

It is important that you have access to your own transport. Hill End is located 80km from the nearest regional centres of Bathurst and Mudgee and is an isolated community.

## Residency Proposals

Applicants should state clearly what they would like to achieve during a residency in Hill End. Important points to consider are:

- Why do you want to participate in the program? Why Hill End? (An engagement with the history and the landscape of the site is a consideration in the selection process.)
- What interaction with the local community would you be willing to undertake? ie open studio, talks or workshops
- The Residency Proposal should be no more than one A4 page in length

## Support Material

- A current CV - not more than two A4 pages
- VISUAL ARTISTS: 10 images a Powerpoint presentation with image captions (title, date, medium and size)
- WRITERS/CURATORS: one copy of up to two manuscripts/ publications/ extracts/ synopsis/ curatorial essays etc
- NEW MEDIA/ FILM/ VIDEO ARTISTS: 10 images in a Powerpoint presentation with image captions (title, date, medium and size) OR one copy of DVD footage - not longer than 15 minutes duration

\* If you are applying using the online form please ensure that all of your submitted files (CV, Proposal & Image presentation) are compressed (zipped) individually for upload.
